The Maryland General Assembly (MGA) is officially in session! For the next 90 days our Governor, Senators and Delegates are expected to tackle a slew of important issues including equity in education, transportation challenges, civil rights, anti-corruption measures and clean energy, to name a few.

For the first time, the MGA proceedings will be accessible via live and/or recorded video. Committee hearings will also be live-streamed. Unfortunately, the mobile viewing feature is still under construction, but hopefully will be up and running soon. In the meantime, you'll need to tune-in on your computer.
